Teachers returned en masse on August 6 for two weeks of “pre-service days”. These days are just packed with spiritual and professional opportunities for us to be equipped for the opportunities and challenges that await us in the new school year. Principals and key administrators provided professional training for our staff in the areas of philosophy of Christian education, starting the school year right, effective communication and documentation of student concerns, instructional design, and meeting the needs of different learners. I am personally so excited and ready for the work the Lord will accomplish through teachers, students, administrators, church and school support staff, pastors, coaches, moms and dads, that is, through the CCA community this year, I can't wait to behold the results. May the Lord empower us that this service is “as unto Him”; may our children's personal relationship with Jesus be deepened and impassioned, and may every tidbit of the glory of it all be unto Him who is Worthy, our Lord Jesus Christ.

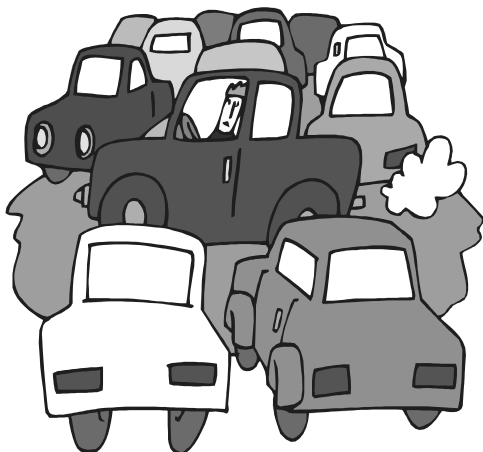

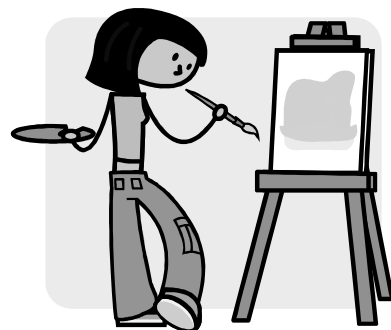
