Dear CCA 11th grade students and parents,

This has certainly been a full and exciting 2009-2010 school year! As we look ahead to what is on the horizon, we are thrilled to inform the junior class of the unique opportunity to develop an expanded worldview and heart for sharing God's love by participating in a missions trip to Merida, Mexico. A few years ago, Calvary Chapel Fort Lauderdale and Calvary Christian Academy Fort Lauderdale began a partnership with a sister school and church in Merida through former CCA employee, Dr. Robert Aguayo. Last summer, working alongside Calvary Merida, CCA's seniors were able to help with the construction of water wells in two neighboring Yucatan villages, Hocaba and Tabi. Also, in Hocaba a church building foundation was prepared, in Tabi a basketball court was built, at the Casa de Abeulos a beautiful garden was planted, and at CCA Merida buildings were painted. All of this was a supplement to Vacation Bible School and street evangelism. The Lord did an amazing work in Mexico and He has called our school to venture out in faith once again!

The dates for this year's mission experience have been scheduled for May 30th to June 6th, 2010. Please mark your calendars now, and begin to pray about how God would orchestrate the needs allowing you to participate! *The cost for the trip will be \$1200.00.*

This experience will certainly provide you the opportunity to be tested, stretched, and refined. As we pray for His leading, direction, and calling, we are also petitioning for His abundant provision for each student to go. RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT
Mexico Missions Trip
May 30 to Jun 6, 2010

I, _____, on this ____ day of _____, 2010 in consideration of my acceptance as short term missions team member for the upcoming Mexico Missions Trip to Merida, Mexico sponsored by Calvary Christian Academy, represent and agree that:

1. I am a volunteer participant.
2. Release: I am aware of the hazards and risks to my person and property associated with serving in a missions capacity, such hazards and risks including, but not being limited to, death or injury by accident, disease, war, terrorist acts, weather conditions, inadequate medical services and supplies, criminal activity, and random acts of violence. I further recognize that such risks have always been associated with missionary service. 2 Corinthians 11:23-28. I hereby release and hold harmless Calvary Chapel Church, Inc., Calvary Christian Academy, Liquid Youth Ministry, their directors, officers, employees and volunteers, hereinafter ("Releasees") from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions and causes of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by me, or any of the property belonging to me while on the missions trip, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees, my own action(s) or otherwise.
3. Medical Release: I attest and certify that I have no medical conditions that would prevent me from performing my duties while on the missions trip. In the event I suffer a sudden illness, accident or injury, I give permission for any emergency treatment that is deemed necessary by a licensed physician.
4. Christian Conciliation: I expressly waive any defense to the enforcement of any provision of this commitment arising from a claim of lack of consideration and warrant that this commitment constitutes a legal, valid, and binding obligation upon me enforceable against me in accordance with its terms. The parties to this agreement are Christians and believe that the Bible commands them to make every effort to live at peace and to resolve disputes with each other in private or within the Christian church (see Matthew 18:15-20; 1 Corinthians 6:1-8). Therefore, the parties agree that any claim or dispute arising from or related to this agreement shall be settled by biblically-based mediation and, if necessary, legally binding arbitration in accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Christian Conciliation of the Institute for Christian Conciliation, a division of Peacemaker® Ministries (complete text of the Rules is available at www.Peacemaker.net). Judgment upon an arbitration decision may be entered in any court otherwise having jurisdiction. The parties understand that these methods shall be the sole remedy for any controversy or claim arising out of this agreement and expressly waive their right to file a lawsuit in any civil court against one another for such disputes, except to enforce an arbitration decision.
5. I am aware of the hazards and risks to my person associated with participation in a field trip or tournament, as described above. I further acknowledge that there is no insurance coverage for me that would apply in the event of my death, illness, injury, or damage to my property that may occur during my participation on the trip, other than any insurance coverage that I may have procured and paid for myself.
6. I further state that I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THE FOREGOING RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS, AND I VOLUNTARILY SIGN THIS RELEASE AS MY OWN FREE ACT ON THE DAY AND YEAR FIRST ABOVE WRITTEN.

To Missions Donors: The following information has been provided to help you make a tax-deductible donation toward this short-term mission trip sponsored by Calvary Chapel. - The IRS regulations for donors state that *checks made payable to individuals are not tax deductible*. A tax deduction may be denied if an individual's name appears on the check.
- If you do not need a tax-deductible donation statement from Calvary Chapel in order to itemize your deductions, you may contribute funds directly to a team member.
- Do not send postdated checks.
- Receipts will be mailed at year-end. If you wish a tax deduction for your gift, please do not contribute cash; instead purchase a money order or cashier's check, made payable to Calvary Chapel.
- *All money is donated to Calvary Chapel and is neither refundable nor transferable*. In the event that a team member raises contributions in excess of the mission trip expenses or decides not to go and cancels, Calvary Chapel will use the money towards other missionary endeavors. All money is donated solely to Calvary Chapel. Financial disbursement is at the discretion of Calvary Chapel for mission work worldwide.
