# ATTENTION Drama Club MEMBERS: Dues Are DUE!

Drama Club membership is open to all secondary students of CCA. To earn this membership, a student must attend Drama Club consistently (Wednesdays from 3:15-4:30) and pay club dues of \$25 (which helps to cover the cost of running club).

These students then work toward membership in the **INTERNATIONAL THESPIAN SOCIETY** – an honor society that recognizes excellence in secondary school theatre.

As stated in Drama Club / Troupe 6817's constitution:

"Dues must be paid before the end of the first grading period unless the member in question is new to the club. If a member fails to pay any dues or money owed to the club, the member will be placed on probation for one grading period. If the student does not pay during this time his/her membership will be terminated. If the member owes the club money at termination, they will be placed on the financial obligation list. All members upon paying Drama Club fees or Thespian dues will receive a membership card to be presented at all meetings and special events."
