This is the technology in use with our Learning Enrichment Lab for students in K – 12 grades. *Our approach focuses on mastery, positive reinforcement and motivation, resulting in significant gains in grade-level equivalencies, test scores, self-esteem and overall performance.*

Our **Learning Enrichment Lab** offers an interactive, computer-based, therapeutic approach to help students K - 12 with learning differences build their language and mental processing skills. The specific therapeutic exercises in these programs are designed to develop new neural, learning patterns and strengthen weak processing areas. The result is a more independent, self confident learner who is able to read, write, and comprehend on an appropriate level.

This program is a unique tool that helps students improve their learning skills by empowering students to overcome sensory processing problems and by helping students develop individual paths to learning. Our approach focuses on mastery, positive reinforcement, and positive, teacher interaction in conjunction with an extremely individualized series of integration exercises. The ten month holistic approach usually results in significant gains in grade-level equivalencies, test scores, self-esteem, and classroom performance.

Evaluation: Prior to approval to enroll, each student participates in nationally normed evaluations here on campus. The Learning Efficiency Test provides an indication of students' efficiency in visual and auditory memory. The Diagnostic Screening Tests for Reading and Spelling provide a baseline for measuring progress and grade-level equivalency. CEI Evaluate™ alleviates the time and redundancy of scoring, graphing and analyzing the evaluations by generating a professional summary of these results that will be discussed in detail with the parent and student.

Sensory Integration Training: Once a ten month contractual commitment is made, the student, during the school day, will begin Sensory Integration Training (SIT) which is a series of progressive activities that exercise the visual, auditory, and motor-kinesthetic pathways in the brain. SIT aids in learning words by giving the brain stimulation in one sensory mode, asking the brain to recall information from memory using a second sensory mode, and having the student respond through a third sensory mode. By completing SIT exercises with correct sequencing and timing, the brain's sensory pathways are interlocked and the result is efficient, reflexive learning. ELS trains auditory and visual senses to work smoothly and quickly with the motor capabilities of speaking and writing. ELS exercises provide the basis for increased learning.
